- Saxony-Anhalt has adapted its measures for the containment of Coronavirus and has permitted a careful easing. Nevertheless, it is essential for each individual to limit his or her direct contacts to the necessary minimum. Please help to protect yourself and others from the virus.
- To prevent the spread of the virus, we all have to adapt our behavior in everyday life, and we all have to particularly observe the following rules:
  - Keep a minimum distance of 1.5 meters from other persons in public.
  - Protect yourself and others by wearing a face mask wherever it is impossible to keep a distance of 1.5 meters.
  - Wash your hands frequently.
  - Avoid greeting by shaking hands or hugging.
  - When you cough or sneeze, always turn away from other people.
    Sneeze or cough into the crook of your arm or a tissue.
  - Do use the "Corona-Warn-App"!
- Meetings and celebrations are only permitted within the members of your own household together with the members of another household that may consist of a maximum of 5 persons. Children under the age of 14 are exempted.

- Restaurants and bars remain closed, but food and beverages can be sold to-go or delivered at home.
- Groceries, pharmacies, drugstores, newspaper kiosks and book stores remain open, delivery or pick-up service remains available.
- Appointment shopping has recently become possible for the retail in Saxony-Anhalt. Customers can book appointments at the shops via telephone or internet
- Cinemas, hotels, amusement halls, fitness centers and amusement parks have to close.
- Sports in clubs are forbidden. Individual sport like jogging is allowed.
- Language and integration courses are currently not taking place in the form of classroom teaching. Already scheduled exams are excluded from this regulation. Virtual teaching is still possible.
- School education takes place in restricted form. From March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, classroom teaching can take place again in elementary and special-needs schools. For all other schools, it is possible to switch to restricted regular school mode.
- Day care centers and kindergartens are open to all children again.
  Restrictions of opening times and provided services are possible.
- Passengers in buses, trains, taxis, etc., as well as customers in shops are required to wear a protective medical face mask (e.g. surgical masks or FFP2 masks).
- In the case of classroom teaching, pupils from class 7 and above are also required to wear a protective face mask at school, if the distance of 1.5 meters cannot be kept.

The following groups of persons do not have to cover their mouths and noses:

- Children under the age of 6 years
- Deaf and hearing-impaired people and their accompanying person
- Persons who cannot wear a face mask because of disability, pregnancy or health reasons
